The **Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Awareness and Security Procedures** course is designed to provide foundational knowledge about IEDs and proper safety precautions and procedures for reacting and responding to unattended and suspicious items.



Course Format and Audience

This 60-minute independent study training (IST) is a self-paced, web-based course covering the following topics:

- IED intimidation
- IED threat awareness
- Public response to IED threats
- USSS agency procedures to IED threats
- DHS agency procedures to IED threats

This course is designed for public and private sector safety personnel and intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officials
- Private sector security professionals
